A FREE Workshop from the University of Hawaii Cooperative Extension Service

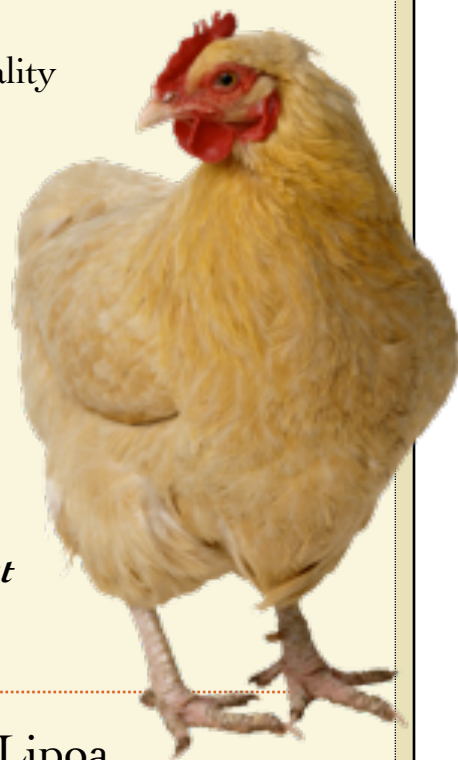
Fresh Eggs and Meat from the Homestead

Includes constructing an example PVC poultry grazing cage.

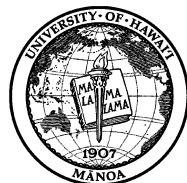
